



## **Sausalito Woman's Club SCHOLARSHIP RECOGNITION FUND**

***Annual Report: July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022***

Through the generosity of SWC members and community supporters, and despite the continuing challenges presented by COVID 19, the Sausalito Woman's Club Scholarship Recognition Fund (SWCSRF) was able to continue its work providing financial support, acknowledgement, and encouragement to deserving scholars in Sausalito and Marin City as they pursue their higher education goals.

The SWCSRF holds at least one major annual fundraiser, historically in November but this year in April for reasons relating to COVID. Our April event was a "Black and White Cocktail Lounge", a stylish cocktail party featuring live music, delicious food, and high-top tables for gathering. Thanks to the generosity of members and friends purchasing tickets, raffle chances, and sponsorships, the SWCSRF netted over \$13,000 from this event.

Some of the funds received by the SWCSRF are "restricted", in that they are designated for students pursuing a specific field of study. Other funds are raised in honor or memory of an individual or individuals, and these may be either restricted or unrestricted, in accordance with the wishes of the honoree or primary funder. However, most of the funds raised are "unrestricted" and may be awarded to students in any field of study.

In June, 2022, the SWCSRF hosted a Scholarship Awards Celebration and Reception, honoring the recipients of scholarships for the academic year 2022-2023. Of the twenty awards presented, 17 were restricted awards: the Heidi and Michael Snowden Scholarship; the Phil Frank Scholarship; the Michael B. Heyman Scholarship; the Mary Beth Fortmann Scholarship; the Dawson Zaugg Scholarship; the Lobo Family and Brandon Yates Scholarship; the Sausalito Presbyterian Church Scholarship; the Claudia and Keith Kennedy Scholarship; the Elizabeth McBride Scholarship; the Mary Park Morison and Lorna Newlin Scholarship; the Shirley Elkington Scholarship; the Diane Bessell Scholarship; the Michele and David Benjamin Scholarship; the Roland Ojeda Scholarship; the Rawley Tandy Scholarship; the Sylvia Ruby Scholarship; and the Elaine B. Squires Scholarship. An additional three scholarships were awarded to deserving local scholars, bringing us to a total of twenty scholarships in an aggregate amount of \$54,000.

Additionally, in partnership with the principal and teachers of our local middle school, Martin Luther King, Jr. Academy, the SWCSRF presented Dream Higher Awards to two graduating eighth graders, Indeyah Sanders and Timmothy Kuroc-Gonzales. This award honors students who have been identified by their teachers as having the potential to achieve their dreams through higher education. It signifies the SWCSRF's pledge to provide a scholarship of at least \$1,000 upon graduation from high school and enrollment in an institution of higher learning.
